Housekeeping: Comfortable pants and shoes. Staff Shirts are provided.

Food Service: Long black pants and non-skid black shoes.

Male employee's hair no longer than collar length or must be pulled back into a ponytail to be above collar length. Hair must be a "natural" color. Eccentric hairstyles or facial hair are not permitted. Jewelry requiring body piercing is prohibited, or may not be visible, except for simple earrings, small nose studs and clear tongue rings. Lip and eyebrow piercings are prohibited. Inappropriate tattoos must not be visible.

* Bring cultural items from home country as employer will have two events in the summer, an International Fair and an International Dinner.

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


* Every employee of the YMCA of the Rockies, including international participants, must have a completed criminal background check prior to starting employment. Employer also requires an online application, two professional references and one family reference be submitted 3 weeks BEFORE arrival. If these items are not submitted before arrival employment will be cancelled.

HOUSING is FREE: Dormitory housing, 2-3 roommates. Lobby with tv, microwave, refrigerator, games. WiFi and phones are in dormitory. Staff must use a calling card to use the phones. In order that our staff can live in a clean environment, we require that residents have rotating cleaning assignments. Failure to accomplish the cleaning assignments will result in a \$50 fine. We also do not allow alcohol in staff housing. If a staff member is found with alcohol or drugs, it will result in immediate termination.

AREA: The Rocky Mountains, commonly known as **the Rockies**, are a major mountain range in western North America. The Rocky Mountains stretch more than 3,000 miles (4,830 km) from the northernmost part of British Columbia, in western Canada, to New Mexico, in the southwestern United States.
